Dear Parents, Teachers and Employees,

In 1986 Congress passed the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). AHERA is a provision of the Toxic Substance Control Act. It requires that LEA's such as The Ranches Academy inspect for asbestos materials, prepare and maintain current AHERA Management Plans, and notify occupants of the plan on a yearly basis. This is done in an effort to prevent exposure of asbestos to the occupants of our building.

The Ranches Academy was built in 2004 and the builder used no asbestos containing materials in the construction. Subsequent additions to the school have also been certified to contain no asbestos. The Ranches Academy is committed to ensuring that our students and staff are not exposed to any hazards posed by asbestos containing materials.

The Ranches Academy's AHERA Management Plan will be available for review and has been submitted to the Utah Department of Environmental Quality/Division of Air Quality.
